## **NOTE TO PROXY**

- 1. Members are entitled to vote at the meeting either in person or by proxy. If you are unable to be present at the meeting, please complete, date, sign, print your name on the Proxy and return same to the Association at or before the meeting.
- 2. The Proxy may be executed by the Member or by his/her attorney authorized in writing. If a Proxy is executed by an attorney, the authority of the attorney to do so act must accompany the Proxy.
- 3. Each Member has the right to appoint a person to attend and act on his/her behalf at the meeting other than the designated above. Such right may be exercised by striking out the names of the designated person and by inserting in the space provided the name of the person to be appointed, who must be a Member of the Association. Pursuant to the bylaw of the Association, a person, other than the Secretary set out above or the President of the Association, can only hold Proxy for no more than one other Member of the Association.
- 4. This Proxy also confers authority for the above-named person to vote in his/her discretion with respect to amendments or variations to matters identified in the notice of the meetings or other matters which may properly come before the meetings or any adjournments thereof.
