#### 2025-26 FALL PLAYER EVALUATIONS

AGE DIVISION	START DATE
U10-U18	May begin on September 6

#### TOURNAMENTS

Tournament participation for all Divisions and Categories permitted to start September 19, 2025.

#### **REGULAR SEASON**

The regular season for all Divisions and Categories permitted to start September 29, 2025.

All teams must be engaged in meaningful competition until **March 1, 2026** – No teams may be eliminated from competition before this date.

#### **SPRING & SUMMER PROGRAMMING OPPORTUNITIES**

Teams selected in the Spring may begin sanctioned Team activity August 25, 2025.

Associations may provide sanctioned individual skills training or hockey schools – August 11-29, 2025.

This programming requires sanctioning from the OMHA and includes registration through the HCR.

The following resource is intended to provide a simplified overview of the key dates with the Playing Regulations for the 2025-26 season.

Playing Regulations and Seasonal Calendars for women and girls' hockey will follow the policies adopted by the Ontario Women's Hockey Association (OWHA).

The seasonal calendar summary below applies to Minor Hockey within the Minor Hockey Alliance of Ontario (ALLIANCE), Greater Toronto Hockey League (GTHL), Northern Ontario Hockey Association (NOHA), and the Ontario Minor Hockey Association (OMHA).



### **REINFORCEMENT OF TERMINOLOGY CHANGE**

Tryouts are referred to as Player Evaluations	To align OHF definitions with the Hockey Canada Player Pathways.
	Player Evaluations provide flexibility in the format that Associations' tier their Registered Participants.
	Tryouts confirm whether a player either makes or does not make a team.
	Player Evaluations enables Associations to tier players at similar skill levels.

# UNDER-11, UNDER-13, UNDER-15, UNDER 18 FALL PLAYER EVALUATION SEASONAL CALENDAR

Applies to Associations outside of the Lake Ontario Region that did not deliver spring Player Evaluations.

Dates listed are the earliest possible. Associations are permitted to shift dates subject to internal needs while ensuring each of the identified Phases are accommodated.

Does not apply to Under-18 AAA.


