

ERIN-HILLSBURGH MINOR HOCKEY ASSOCIATION - HOCKEY REGISTRATION REFUND POLICY

THIS POLICY IS EFFECTIVE MARCH 10TH 2022, AND ANY PREVIOUS VERSIONS ARE CONSIDERED NULL AND VOID.

PURPOSE:

To establish policy and process for refunding players their hockey registration fees. At times, due to different circumstances, a player may request a refund.

Team fees are not covered by this Refund Policy.

All refunds must be requested by completing a Refund Request Form through the ehmha.ca website: <https://ehmha.ca/Forms/6243/>

POLICY:

For REP, LOCAL LEAGUE and U5/7 participants, refunds will be granted if applied for: within 7 days after the final team selection has been posted on the EHMHA website **OR** prior to September 15th of the current season, whichever comes first.

If the above criteria have been met, fees will be refunded at 100%, less a \$50 administrative fee.

Once any outstanding borrowed equipment is returned, the designated EHMHA Exec staff will process the refund according to the refund procedure.

Refunds will not be given due to suspensions or any other contravention of the association's code of conduct that results in the player being barred from playing by the association, the OMHA, the OHF and/or the referee's association regardless of the date of the request.

Request for refunds made prior to December 31st of the current season due to **illness or injury**, that results in a player missing the entirety of the remainder of the season will be determined by the Board. All such refund requests will require a doctor's note, provided, and paid for by the family, that states the player cannot participate in organized hockey for the remainder the season. The Board will review on a case-by-case basis and may approve a pro-rated refund less a \$50 administration fee.
