INTRODUCTION

This model adheres to the key concepts and principles of the Canadian Player Pathways framework. In addition, it closely mirrors the structure and format implemented in 2022-23.

The Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) has approved Player Evaluations (Tryouts) for the 2023-24 season for age-groups U10 through U18 to be conducted during the Spring of 2023 (OHF Bulletin 22-34).

OHF Championships are scheduled for the 4th weekend of April – **April 21-23, 2023**.

Player Evaluations would begin the Monday following OHF Championships - April 24, 2023.

FALL PLAYER EVALUATION

Teams at AA & Below (outside LOR) may deliver Player Evaluations in the Fall.
